MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The following are the basic requirements for application of membership in the Long Beach Yacht Club:

- It is a requirement that anyone interested in applying for membership in Long Beach Yacht Club must be sponsored by a proposer and either two or three* seconders in good standing for a minimum of two years. The Proposer and seconders are expected to know the prospect well, to be aware of their boating experience and verify the applicant is of sound character.

*** THIRD SECONDER IS REQUIRED IF PROPOSING MEMBER IS NOT ENTITLED TO VOTING RIGHTS**

- Applicant should have boating experiences with either their sponsors or with other members of the Club.
- Applications are available on line at lbyc.org under the Membership tab or available at the Front Desk. Currently, the application process takes approximately three - four months.

Upon receipt of the application it is logged in and processed according to the date of receipt. At that time the member application is posted in the YAK for 30 days. The Membership Committee will thoroughly investigate all applicants and recommend approval or denial of membership to the Board of Directors who will make final determination of acceptance or denial.

The Membership Committee and the Board will require substantial proof from all new membership applicants that they either have proven past yachting experience and intend to continue that experience or can demonstrate that they intend to participate actively in yachting activities of the Club.

A table designating our current initiation fees, monthly dues and assessments and quarterly food and beverage minimums is included.

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Basic Information

1. It is a requirement that anyone interested in applying for membership in Long Beach Yacht Club must be sponsored by a proposer and either two or three seconders in good standing for a minimum of two years. The Proposer and seconders are expected to know the prospect well, to be aware of their boating experience and verify the applicant is of sound character.
2. The applicant should include a letter of interest which states their reason for wishing to join the Club.
3. Each sponsor should include a letter of recommendation for the applicant.
4. The applicant should include a recent photo.
5. The application will not be considered unless all questions are completely answered.
6. The membership is for a single applicant only. There are no joint, family or corporate memberships at the Club.
7. Further information is listed in the Club's Bylaws.

Applications for consideration should be complete (including all sponsor letters and signature page) and delivered to the Front Desk.

Regular Membership

Initiation Fee:	\$9,000 (\$5,000 transfer fee; \$4,000 equity)
Monthly Dues:	\$ 275 (\$262 dues; \$13 reserve)
Food & Beverage Minimum:	\$ 180 (Quarterly)

Intermediate Membership (Ages 18-39)

Initiation fee:	\$ 500
Monthly Dues:	
➤ Ages 18-22	\$ 70
➤ Ages 23-27	\$ 100
➤ Ages 28-32	\$ 130
➤ Ages 33-39	\$ 180
Quarterly F&B Minimums:	
➤ Ages 28-32	\$ 72
➤ Ages 33-39	\$ 135

Intermediate Member Transfer Fund*:

- 50% of monthly dues

* transfer fee amount will be fixed at the date of Intermediate Membership or current transfer rate whichever less is. Any surplus in the member's fund over required conversion cost (transfer fee and member equity acquisition cost) will be retained by LBYC.

MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Regular Membership

Any person over the age of 21 is eligible for election to the Club as a Regular Member.

Intermediate Membership

Any person ages 18-39 is eligible for election to the Club as an Intermediate Member. Intermediate Members shall be reviewed by the Membership Committee and Board of Directors annually.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE MINIMUM

Long Beach Yacht Club has a food and beverage minimum of \$180 per quarter. Only dining and bar purchases charged to your account will be credited to the minimum. Please note that this does not include service fee or tax.

The quarter ends on the last day of the months indicated below, based on the first letter of the member's last name.

A – F:	January, April, July, October
G – O:	February, May, August, November
P – Z:	March, June, September, December

The monthly billing statement reflects the amount of unused minimum remaining for the quarter. Should you not spend \$180 on food or beverages by the end of your designated quarter, the amount unused will then be charged to your account.
