NOTICE OF SERIES

Amended December 19, 2023

1 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) will be each of the four clubs with events in the series.

2 SCHEDULE

The California Dreamin' Series (CDS) will consist of four match racing events: the San Diego Yacht Club Stop on January 27-28, 2024 in J/22 type boats, the Balboa Yacht Club Stop on February ~~18-19~~ 17-18, 2024 in GovCup 21 type boats, the St. Francis Yacht Club Stop on March 16-17, 2024 in J/22 type boats, and the Long Beach Yacht Club Stop on April 6-7, 2024 in Catalina 37 type boats.

3 RULES

The Notices of Race and Sailing Instructions for each event shall apply.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Any skipper entered in at least one event is automatically entered in the CDS. There is no entry fee for the CDS. **Skippers who request an invitation to three stops shall be given priority for acceptance at each stop.**
- 4.2 Up to eight (8) skippers will be invited to each Stop of the CDS. Skippers may request invitations to one or more of the events.
- 4.3 The application period for all events starts on December 15, 2023. Skippers may request invitations to individual qualifying events online by submitting the [2024 CDS RFI Form](#).

5 SCORING

- 5.1 Skippers shall receive points based on their finish in each of the events in the CDS. If a skipper does not enter an event, they shall receive zero (0) points for that event. Event points shall be applied based on the schedule below. The final series score shall be based on the highest total of event points, counting the best three event scores for a skipper. The skipper with the highest series score shall be declared the winner of the CDS, except that the **Long Beach Yacht Club Stop shall be counted as one of the scored events if the skipper wishes to receive an invitation to Ficker Cup 2025. Thus, the winner of CDS might not necessarily receive an invitation to Ficker Cup, which would go to the highest scoring skipper who included LBYC in their series points.**

5.2 If a series tie exists between two or more skippers, they shall be ranked in order of their scores in the Long Beach Yacht Club Stop. This changes RRS A8.
